Pastor Karen's Corner

Happy New Year! I hope these Twelve Days of Christmas have brought moments of joy, laughter, and love, and a renewed sense of God's abiding presence. I also want to thank you for the generous gift and the Christmas cards. Doug and I deeply appreciate all the ways you show us your support and care. It is a joy to serve you!

Friends, we will not have time for winter doldrums to set in this month. I want to lift up several events/programs that are happening in our church, for your prayer support and participation.

On the 3rd, our Staff-Parish board members will be meeting with our District Superintendent to work on a profile of our congregation that will be used in the discernment process for assigning your next pastor. As part of this discernment, members of the congregation also will be asked to participate in a congregational survey, so you can indicate what is most important to you about your life together and our congregation's call to ministry. More information on this will be coming soon.

On the 10th, we will have four young people starting confirmation class! Please pray for Grace, Kaitlyn, Max and Sydney, that this will be a great experience for them of growing and finding joy in their faith.

On the 21st, we will have a congregational meeting following worship. We'll be sharing a working budget for 2024, begin the follow-up on our World Café work, and have some other information and updates to share. As you think about our top three World Café topics (building relationships and community, both in and outside the church, children and youth and outreach for church growth and mission), consider where and how you want to be involved in this ongoing discernment and planning.

On the 28th, we will have a special guest in our Sunday worship. The Rev. Paul Witmer will participate in leadership with me, and I've invited him to share about the ministry he is currently leading. Paul is a Disciples of Christ pastor who is currently appointed as pastor of Women at the Well United Methodist Church, a UMC congregation located inside the Iowa Correctional Institution for Women in Mitchellville, Iowa. He also was one of my teachers in the PrairieFire program, which led me into training as a Spiritual Director.

Just think, this is only the beginning of 2024! We have so much to be thankful for, and so much good to do together, for the sake of the kingdom.
