After Jesus' resurrection, the first disciples realized that their journey with him would continue throughout their lives. As with them, learning what it means to follow Jesus is a life-long adventure for us, too. This first day after Easter is a good time to offer gratitude for those who have walked/are walking with us along the Way.
